

Horticulture Level 3

This course is designed for those with some previous experience of horticulture and combines knowledge and practical work with employment experience.

What will I study?

This qualification is designed for those with some previous experience of horticulture and wanting to work in outdoor jobs and combines knowledge and practical work with employment experience. The course reflects the skills and knowledge needed to pursue a career in amenity horticulture.

What modules are covered?

Diploma in Work-Based Horticulture Level 3

Mandatory:

- Promote, monitor and maintain health, safety and security of the workplace
- Estimate and programme resources requirements for landscaping
- Manage your own resources
- Specify the maintenance of landscapes
- Monitor landscape maintenance and inspect landscape features and facilities

Optional Units: to be chosen with the employer/assessor/tutor

What qualification will I gain?

Advanced Apprenticeship Level 3 Work-Based Diploma in Horticulture (Landscaping)

Functional maths and English Level 2

How will I be assessed?

Assessments are of a practical and theoretical nature and are carried out throughout the course. This can be done by a range of methods including written and verbal assessment. Most of the evidence of competence will be gathered in the workplace.

What are the entry requirements?

Minimum Level 2 Horticulture qualification or Supervisory Horticulture experience.

What else do I need to know?

During the course you will also cover:

- Employers rights and responsibilities workbook
- Apprenticeship logbook
